Seville Family's 80% Bill Cut: Real Data

The Rojas family (4-bed villa, pool) spent EUR2,900 annually on electricity. After installing 8kW panels + 10kWh storage:

Annual bill: EUR584

Excess energy sold: EUR320 income

CO2 saved: 4.8 tons/year

Cutting Through Spain's New Solar Laws

2025's Royal Decree 487 simplified permits but added grid stability requirements. Key changes:

15-day approval for systems under 15kW

Mandatory anti-glare coating in historic zones

The Balearic Islands Exception

Mallorca now requires solar on all new buildings - but offers 50% subsidies. Hotel chain Melia reports 22% occupancy boost from eco-conscious travelers.
